











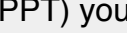

Divide that by 4 and take the Difference (<math>\Delta</math>) between it and the next. Divide that by 3 to give the PREVIOUS PPT c-value in the series.</p> <p>The variable divisor <math>3 = \text{Sub-Matrix 2 value} / 4 = 12/4</math>.</p>						
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
